Entrepreneurship and making business in the Black Sea Region

In 1997 I have initiated at the Neptun Tv Channel, a Tv Show called "Vision, Value & Courage" to promote the spirit of entrepreneurship and the best practices from the Constanta region. I was sure that there were many examples entrepreneurs, and of somebody had discover to and promote them. But, very soon, I understood that the entrepreneurial native talents have to be doubled by the knowledge and skills of making business. At those times, the business schools were at the very beginning in our region and the business education



was not taken very serious. The economy was passing a very major shift from a centralized socialist system to a very incipient market economy. Constanta, Romania

Under the frame of the 4BIZ Project, on the 29th of February, 2024, it was organized the Regional Brokerage event "Boosting Black Sea Blue Biz -4BIZ", in Constanta. event gathered entrepreneurs, representatives of innovative companies, start-ups and stakeholders from Romania, Ukraine, Bulgaria, Turkey,



Georgia, Greece and France, including regional development agencies, chambers of commerce, innovative clusters, universities and support organizations.

The event aimed to offer a framework for B2B, B2G, B2C collaborations by facilitating the exchange of Blue Business ideas, best practices and knowledge in order to identify new directions to be followed for conceiving successful entrepreneurial activities.

With spoke a welcome speech at the opening pannel Prof. Eden **MAMUT**, 4BIZ Project Coordinator Ion **MOCANU**, President, Galati Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture (online), Sonia **KARASAVVIDOU**, Project Officer, European Commission, Olena **ZHUKOVA** Executive Director of the PU "Ukrainian Maritime Cluster", **Mehmet Bozdogan** Head of the Project Development and Implementation Unit at Eastern Black Sea Development Agency (**DOKA**)

During the speech, the 4BIZproject coordinator informed the participants of the event with the results of the project implementation, at which stage it is and voiced the main policy recommendation for support blue business in the Black Sea region. Namely:

- Strengthening the framework for promoting the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship with a deep respect to the marine and coastal environment: the Sikorsky Innovation Challenge model
- Establishing and supporting the development of competence centres on blue economy by the involvement of universities and scientific research communities
- Highly professional support services for the entrepreneurs and managers of businesses in the field of blue economy
- Dedicated/targeted investments funds with expertise in blue economy businesses specific for the conditions of the Black Sea Region
- Inter-governmental cooperation for large scale projects as the ferry-line connections between the Black Sea Ports

Implementation of Support Services for The Pilot Companies



Under EMFAF 4BIZ Project's "Implementation of Support Services for The Pilot Companies" work package activity, trainings were given to 5 aquaculture and fisheries processing MSMEs of Trabzon in the field of R&D, efficiency, innovation, quality assurance systems, aquaculture technics, product diversification, sustainable environment, circular economy, fish diseases and diagnosis in SUMAE (Central Fisheries Research Institute) by Recep Tayyip Erdoğan University and SUMAE experts.

With the help of these trainings, increasing these 5 MSMEs institutional capacities are targeted. 3 of MSMEs planning to invest in Atlantic Salmon which is a new and high value-added export product for our region, received trainings on advanced farming techniques and these companies started to make regulatory researches, technical and financial analyses for the realization of this investment. Mentoring service in the field of production of protein hydrolyzate from fish waste, has been started for one of MSMEs by SUMAE experts. Additionally, to develop the entrepreneurship and investment capacity of these 5 MSMEs, business counselling service under DOKA specialists guidance in the field of public supports and incentives, investment licences and permissions is ongoing effectively.



ICBSS' COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS ON BLUE ECONOMY BETWEEN THE BLACK SEA & OTHER EU SEA-BASINS

Within the framework of the 4BIZ project, the **International Centre for Black Sea Studies** (ICBSS) extended research outside the Black Sea to other EU sea basins, i.e. Baltic Sea, Atlantic Ocean, Mediterranean Sea including Adriatic and Ionian Region, with the aim to identify good practices at policy and operational levels that could support the mitigation of challenges for blue businesses in the Black Sea.

The report, entitled "Report on the assessment and identification of best practices of other regions and sea-basins that could match with the identified gaps", provides a review of policies

at regional and national level in the selected sea-basins, and highlights good practices of supporting mechanisms and blue businesses. Its results fed the ongoing research and consultation activities, and supported the development of pilot services under the 4BIZ project.


